NORTHSIDE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

- Prepared in 2018.
- The goal of the plan was to take steps towards the stabilization and revitalization of the New Horizons community.
- Community input meetings were held to see what the citizens wanted to see in their neighborhood.
- Community Wish List included: connectivity, preservation, goods and services, and vibrancy.

HWY 92 RELOCATION PROJECT

- Relocation of State Route 92
- Improved connectivity for the New Horizons Community
- The underpass is currently open to traffic
- McCarley Street Railroad Crossing Relocation - intersection improvements to protect left turn movements, signalized intersection.
- Overall Completion Date of Project- February 2022

JESSIE DAVIS PARK AND ALICE HAWTHORNE COMMUNITY CENTER

- Park area currently undergoing renovations
- Currently working on integrating into the proposed trail system that correlates with Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan
- Gymnasium renovations completed
- Basketball court renovations are complete
- New gymnasium
- Associated parking and driveway areas
- A new retention pond
- Two future building sites that will be constructed for pad-ready development

WILLING WORKERS PARK

- Renovations currently ongoing
- Renovations Include:
 - Reconfiguring the park entrance
 - Adding multiple pavilion areas
 - Restrooms
 - Basketball court
 - Playground improvements
 - Pedestrian bridges along the proposed nature trails
- Groundbreaking on renovations held on April 18th

BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN PLAN

- Walking and biking infrastructure currently being implemented through Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan
- Dallas Hwy project moving forward. Project includes a 10 ft shared use path from McCarley Street to Brown Street. The project is identified in the Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.

NORTH SIDE TRAIL SYSTEM:

- Concepts/Design Plan prepared by Croy Engineering adopted on October 15, 2020. Next step is to pull a project or two and submit to ARC during Transportation Improvement Project (TIP) solicitation, which should be at the end of 2021. Staff working on plan and will provide a recommendation on which trail system to start with for the first project.
