## Rules & Regulations

## **Christmas Parade**

- We encourage each participant to celebrate the theme of this year's Christmas Parade! The
  theme is "Miracle on Main Street." We recognize that it is not always possible, however, the
  general theme of the parade is "Christmas" and we expect each entry to follow this general
  theme.
- 2. In order to not confuse the children, there will only be one live Santa Claus, which is provided by Main Street Douglasville. If a live Santa Claus is in your entry, your entry will be disqualified and taken out of the parade line-up. No exceptions!
- 3. Each entry must be decorated with lights due to the time of the event. No exceptions!
- 4. Length of vehicle(s) and/or float must be listed on registration form. This total length of entry is to include number of vehicles, trailers, etc.
- 5. The determination of entry placement and category is governed by the City Manager and is final.
- 6. Only Christmas Music shall be played.
- 7. No alcohol allowed.
- 8. No tractors or semi-trucks allowed. Roll back wreckers may be permitted.
- 9. For safety reasons, no items of any kind are to be thrown to the crowd from anyone on a moving vehicle this includes flyers and candy. Should you wish to hand out items, you may have walkers hand out items. Items may not be thrown.
- 10. All entries must stay at least 15-20 feet from the entry ahead.
- 11. No speeding during the parade or during the parade line-up.
- 12. Drivers of any type of entry may not leave vehicle/float.
- 13. All occupants must remain seated inside truck beds NO Standing!
- 14. No riding on truck bed fender walls, top of truck cab, or on side of truck beds.
- 15. You must have rear view mirrors on all towed or self-propelled floats.
- 16. You must have a 36 inch railing on all floats and trailers to be able to carry riders.
- 17. All float riders must remain seated at all times NO jumping or standing on floats!

- 19. All floats must have two adult spotters with children riders.
- 20. Spotters must walk alongside of designated seating area of floats.
- 21. Spotters are not allowed to hand out candy or objects.
- 22. You must have a 36 inch railing on roll back wreckers if you have riders.
- 23. You must have two adult spotters for roll back wreckers with children riders.
- 24. Any entry violating any of the above rules or not keeping with the theme of the parade will be immediately removed from the parade and will be subject to disqualification from future parade participation.
- 25. Application Deadline is November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Applications can be returned via email to parkera@douglasvillega.gov, in person at Douglasville City Hall (6695 Church Street) or mailed to 6695 Church Street Douglasville, GA 30134.

**Route:** The staging area for the parade will be on Church Street in front of ACE Hardware. The parade will go west on Church Street and conclude at Club Drive. See a sample of the route from last year below.
