This permit is non-transferable and granted only to the applicant and/or organization listed below. The Chief of Police may impose reasonable safety restrictions upon this permit.

The City of Douglasville is not liable for any injuries an applicant, participant or spectator may sustain during the parade event.

This permit may be revoked by the Chief of Police or his designee at any time if there is a substantial threat or impediment to public safety or to traffic efficiency. The city council and the Chief of Police may also impose reasonable conditions upon this permit including but not limited to scope, date, time, location, and security requirements.

Sec. 82-5. - Parades — Permit.

Except for funeral processions, no parade or procession containing five or more persons or two or more vehicles, shall occupy, march or proceed along any street or sidewalk so as to obstruct or slow the normal flow of traffic, except in accordance with a parade permit issued by the city council or the chief of police. The city council and the chief of police may impose reasonable conditions upon such permit regarding scope, date, time, location, and security requirements.
